
July 15 (April 15) - Everybody File Annual Taxes with the IRS

July 15 (April 15) - Private Practice Owners Send Estimated Quarterly Tax Payment to IRS (1st Quarter)

July 15 (June 15)- Private Practice Owners Send Estimated Quarterly Tax Payment to IRS (2nd Quarter)

September 15 - Private Practice Owners Send Estimated Quarterly Tax Payment to IRS (3rd Quarter)

September 30th (April 1-Sept 30)- All Medical Professionals Renewal of your Professional Licenses if it was originally due between April 1, 2020 - September 30, 2020



### **Telehealth & Federal HIPAA Regulations During COVID-19**

The Office of Civil Rights (OCR) has indicated they will exercise enforcement discretion and waive penalties for HIPAA violations against health care providers that serve patients in good faith through FaceTime or Skype.

US Department of Health & Human Services Statement

### **Telehealth Health Insurance Coverage/Parity in WA State**

I [Inslee] also prohibit the following activities by health carriers to encourage health care providers to provide telemedicine services by providing for payment parity between telemedicine and inperson medical services:

1. Reimbursing in-network providers for telemedicine claims for medically necessary covered services at a rate lower than thecontracted rate that would be paid if the services had been delivered through traditional (in-person) methods.

2. Denying a telemedicine claim from an in-network provider for a medically necessary covered service due to an existing provider contract term with that provider that denies reimbursement for services provided through telemedicine.

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### WA State & Federal Information to Know (continued)

### Telehealth Health Insurance Coverage/Parity in WA State

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3. Establishing requirements for the payment of telemedicine services that are inconsistent with the emergency orders, rules or technical advisories to carriers issued by the Office of the Insurance Commissioner.

Violators of this of this order may be subject to criminal penalties pursuant to RCW 43.06.220(5).

### WA State Declaration to extend Renewing Medical Licenses


